From the Pastor ...

O give thanks to the LORD, for he is good, for his steadfast love endures forever. – Ps. 136:1

November is one of my favorite months of the year. My youngest would say it is because she was born in November... and that is true, but it's not the only reason. In my head and heart, November is the time of gathering: of fall leaves into big piles, of friends around times of fellowship, of family members usually far-flung, of family recipes for a feast. It is harvest time, when the oncetall corn stalks are now cut down, the cotton bolls are compacted into bales , and the earth settles in for a season of rest.

November is also a time of year when congregations typically finish out the annual stewardship drive and treasurers fanatically try to make ends meet for the coming year's ministry needs. I know that in the various churches I have served, I am asked to 'preach on stewardship.' And of course I say yes to the request, but I am also somewhat taken aback by the request because, in my heart of hearts, stewardship is not something I believe relegated to a few Sundays each year. It is a lifestyle, enacted every day of our lives.

Being a disciple of Jesus means living in obedience to God and responding to God's grace out of the abundance with which God has blessed each of us. Day in, day out, we are to live responsively to God's grace. Day in, day out, we tell the world, by how we live, what we believe and who we serve. Therefore, in many ways, I believe and hope that every sermon I preach has something to do with being a disciple of Jesus, a child of God, and living that out.

You are a child of God too. You, too, are asked, from the abundance of God given to you, to return a portion – a tithe – back to God. My hope and prayer is that you will, indeed, make a pledge for the coming year of ministry for St. Andrew in this season of gathering. You are St. Andrew, and the work does not get done and the ministry does not happen without you. Prayerfully consider your response to the grace and abundance of God in your life and how you can respond and be part of ministry of this congregation for the coming year.

Financial Report

Our income and expenses for YTD September 2013 were as follows:

Contributions for September YTD 2013 \$166,896

Expenses for September 2013 YTD 145,195

Our income for the first nine months of 2013 has remained ahead of our expectations. Our expenses trailed the budgeted level by just over

\$33,000. A significant portion of the "below-budget expenses" was due to the lack of pastor and the associated costs. A detailed report of this information is posted on the bulletin board across from the fellowship hall.

We are about to begin a new and exciting chapter in the history of St. Andrew, and we are in decent financial condition. We do need to be aware that our 2013 pledge level will not meet the expected expenditures in 2014, so our excitement will need to reach into our pockets a little deeper to



maintain our financial state. On November 10 we will have the opportunity to make our 2014 pledges to the church so that our session can plan our ministries for 2014.

Session Notes

The following items are highlights from the October 6, 2013, congregational meeting and the October 10, 2013, stated session meeting:

- 1. The members voted on October 6, 2013, to elect Ceil Hydrick, John Jordan and Turner Matthews as elders and John Newbill as trustee, all for the Class of 2016. In addition, the congregation approved a reduction in the size of each class of elders, from four to three, beginning with the Class of 2016. Once two more classes have been elected, the session will consist of nine members.
- 2. The minutes for the congregational meeting of October 6, 2013, and the stated session meeting of September 12, 2013, were approved by the session on October 10, 2013.
- 3. Our membership was reduced to 125 as of September 30, 2013, due to the death of Juanita Kuykendall on September 10, 2013.
- 4. A thank-you note was received from Decatur Music Club, expressing their appreciation for

the use of our facility on numerous occasions.

- 5. Stu Strong was elected as elder-commissioner to the fall meeting of North Alabama Presbytery, held at Camp Maranatha on October 15, 2013.
- 6. The session approved a wedding request for Samantha Kelly and Billy Locker, to be held on November 2, 2013.
- Elder training will be conducted by Rev. Mueller for one evening a week for four weeks, beginning on November 4, 2013.
- 8. Expectations of elders, who are primarily spiritual leaders of the congregation, were reviewed by Rev. Mueller.
- 9. A position description for a church administrative assistant was approved by the session in order to move forward and find a replacement for Beth Clymer. Beth will be leaving us by the end of December, so we will move quickly.
