Our New Pastor - the Rev. Dr. Toby Mueller

On Sunday, August 25, 2013, the St. Andrew congregation met for the purpose of issuing a call to the Rev. Dr. Toby Mueller as Designated Pastor of our congregation. She comes to us with 17 years of experience in the pastorate, and we are excited and eagerly looking forward to God's next plans for His body here.



Dr. Mueller (Toby) was born in San Francisco, and then raised in Palo Alto, California, and Lake Havasu City, Arizona. Her B.A. is from the University of Arizona (Tucson) in elementary education. She taught grades 4-6 before going to seminary. Her husband, Mark, also began his career in education. God's call led them to seminary in Louisville, where they both graduated in 1996 with Masters of Divinity degrees. She also holds a Doctor of Ministry degree from Columbia Theological Seminary.

Before coming to the area four years ago, she served with and among the churches of the Presbytery of South Alabama, where she lived for 12 years. Since moving to the North Alabama Presbytery, she has served Trinity PC (Huntsville), First PC (Guntersville) and First PC (Sheffield), as well as serving as the stated clerk for the North Alabama Presbytery.

Dr. Mueller's husband, Mark, serves as pastor at First PC in Huntsville. They have two grown daughters: Lauren, 28, was recently a high school math teacher and volleyball coach in South Carolina, and is now enrolled at Duke Divinity School, seeking ordination. Ashley, 24, has a degree in communication and spent the last year in missions around the world, serving in 11 countries in 11 months.

Dr. Mueller's first service at St. Andrew will be September 29, 2013.
